

Resolution #8-2026: Request for Main Street Speed Limit Reduction

WHEREAS, the Village Board of the Village of Middleburgh requests a speed limit reduction on Main Street, commencing at approximately 113 Main Street at the Village/Town boundary and traveling northwest for 1.1 miles to the intersection of Main Street and River Street;

WHEREAS, Main Street is partially residential, partially commercial, and includes two public schools with accompanying crosswalks;

WHEREAS, residents are concerned because vehicles travel too fast for conditions, and speeding motorists prove dangerous to pedestrians.

NOW, THEREFORE, **BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Village of Middleburgh Board of Trustees is requesting that the New York State Department of Transportation investigate reducing the posted speed limit from 30 MPH to 25 MPH on Main Street in the Village of Middleburgh.
